In addition to being a member of the El Paso Symphony, Marianne Shifrin is Principal Clarinet of the New Mexico Philharmonic and has been a member of the Arizona Opera Orchestra since 2010. Previously, Marianne has held positions with the Civic Orchestra of Chicago, the Greeley Philharmonic Orchestra in Colorado, and the Columbus Indiana Philharmonic.

She has performed as guest principal with the Phoenix and Tucson Symphonies, the Colorado Springs Philharmonic, and the Colorado Ballet Orchestra, as well as serving as an extra musician with many other orchestras around the Southwest and in Colorado.

Marianne has performed at the Music Academy of the West, and the Aspen, Sarasota, Chautauqua, and Bowdoin music festivals. She spends her summers performing with the Artosphere Festival Orchestra in Arkansas, and the Missouri Symphony.

Marianne's chamber music appearances include the Phoenix Winter Chamber Music Festival, Albuquerque's Chatter Series, and as clarinetist with the August Winds, a Dallas based wind quintet. Marianne received her Bachelor of Music Degree and a Performer Diploma from Indiana University, and her Master of Music degree from Yale University. Her principal teachers include Eli Eban, David Shifrin, and Bil Jackson.
